301	/21	<p>Chairman's Remarks: Noted that Cllr. Wragg had been unwell and had an operation. The council wished her well in her recovery. Noted that a magnolia tree planted near the war memorial had been planted by the youngest brownie and oldest guide to commemorate the centenary of Lord Baden Powell. Chair to speak to current guide leader. The recent footpaths problems had now been repaired according to Highways. There have been no updates received from Highways regarding the work on North Road despite repeated attempts by this council to contact the project manager.</p>

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305	/21	<p>Planning: Applications</p> <p>SL/2022/0122 at 71 Pear Tree Park, Holme – Application for a Lawful Development Certificate (Proposed) for a sing storey rear extension to enlarge the kitchen</p> <p>RESOLVED that there were no objections to this application.</p>	
306	/21	<p>Other Matters:</p> <p><u>Police Report</u> – The most recent report had been circulated and there were no comments to make. RESOLVED to ask the PCSO to come to the Annual Parish Meeting in April.</p> <p><u>Square Project</u> – Phase 1 Concept Design is still awaited from Lakeland Gardens.</p> <p><u>Playground Safety</u> – Permission had now been granted by SLDC. Work will commence shortly, preferably in the Easter holidays.</p> <p><u>Village Shop</u> – Noted that the prospective new shop keeper was to visit again on Wednesday and had asked to meet with the Chair and Clerk. Still very keen to re-open the shop but is still awaiting further information.</p> <p><u>Jubilee 2022</u> –Noted that Cllr. Breaks had contacted most of the local groups and organisations and a small sub committee had been formed. A timetable was roughly in place and this would be published as soon as possible. Any further ideas should be passed to Cllr. Breaks.</p> <p><u>Trees</u> – Noted that two trees near the war memorial looked in dangerous condition. RESOLVED to ask Cllr. Hancock to take a look at these as soon as possible.</p> <p>Ukrainian Flag – It had been suggested that a Ukrainian Flag be hoisted on the flag pole to show support after the Russian invasion. It was noted that it was not appropriate for the Parish Council to get involved in this dispute in any way and a flag should therefore not be hoisted. However, Individuals were free to put flags up on their own property.</p>
