396	/23	<p>Apologies for absence: RESOLVED to accept apologies and record the reason from Cllr. Breaks.</p>													
397	/23	<p>Declarations of Interest: RESOLVED that there were no interests to declare.</p>													
398	/23	<p>Minutes of the meeting on Monday 05 December 2022: RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting on Monday 05 December 2022 were a correct record and a copy was signed by the Chair.</p>													
399	/23	<p>Chairman's Remarks: The Chair noted that he had received complaints about the condition of the footway on Mayfield Avenue which were to be reported to highways. Noted that the bus shelter outside the church had now been repaired. Noted that a large stone at the entrance to the war memorial had been knocked over and would require repairing. Noted that the temporary footway barriers on Burton Road bridge had come apart and needed to be replaced or removed. Work on North Road would recommence in February. Noted the large pothole halfway up North Road which had been reported to highways.</p>													
400	/23	<p>County and District Councillor Remarks: Cllr Bingham had submitted a report which had been shared with all councillors. Cllr Bingham gave a brief summary of this report and noted that the recent sad fatal accident had not been a result of ungritted roads. This would be Cllr Bingham's last meeting before he retired and he wished the council well in the future. The Chair noted Cllr Bingham's long service and thanked him for this before wishing him well in his retirement.</p>

It was reported that the stile at the top of the canal near Holme Mills was broken. It was suggested that the landowner would need to repair this and it was RESOLVED to get in touch with the landowner.</p>

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403	/23	<p>Planning: There had been no applications or decisions since the last meeting.</p>											
404	/23	<p>Other Matters: <u>Police Report</u> – There had been no report received since the last meeting. <u>Square Project</u> – RESOLVED to deal with this business at the end of the meeting. <u>Duke Street</u> – Noted that a new meeting with Highways had been arranged for Wednesday 08 December 2023. <u>Village Shop</u> – A notice had been produced to place in the window of the shop. At this stage there is nothing more the council can do. <u>North Road</u> – Works will recommence in February and letters are to be sent to all affected properties. <u>Sheernest Lane</u> – It was suggested that the grass verge on Sheernest Lane be cut by our lengthsman. The lengthsman had been approached and had confirmed that there would be no extra cost for this work. RESOLVED to approve the lengthsman to do this work. <u>Square Project</u> – Two quotes had been received, however, there was some discussion about whether the plans were as agreed by the council. It was RESOLVED that all of the current parking spaces should remain as parking was at a premium in the centre of the village and removing this facility would likely cause further problems on Duke Street. It was RESOLVED that a definitive plan of what is required should be drawn up and presented to the next meeting. This could then be approved and the two interested contractors could be asked for their quotation based on this plan. This made the process transparent and fair .</p>
